In 2016, OMLCIA spent \$10,090 to improve lake water quality. In addition, we received \$40,360 from LARE grants. How were these funds spent? READ on!

In 2017, we want to continue improving water quality. The following projects are planned, one of which is contingent on a LARE grant. We will know in early 2017 if our LARE application is funded.

2016 PROJECTS

- Conducted Aquatic Vegetation Management Plan update project including spring invasive weeds survey, invasive weed treatment, post-treatment invasive weed survey and update AVMP. Total cost \$12,000. (LARE \$9,600; OMLCIA \$2,400).
- Conducted Phase 1 of sediment removal project in Dove Creek, South of 450 South out into Oliver Lake. Total cost \$76,900. (LARE grant \$61,500; OMLCIA cash match \$15,400). 2016 Phase 1 cost \$38,450 (LARE grant \$30,760; OMLCIA cash match \$7,690).
- Successfully petitioned the LaGrange County Drainage Board to increase the annual ditch tax for Dove Creek to raise approximately \$5,600 per year for ditch maintenance, including project to dredge two sediment catch basins located in creek to the North of 450 S.
- Actively participated in a new initiative to identify water improvement and control projects in the North Branch Elkhart River Watershed, resulting in a grant of \$250,000 from the Great Lakes Commission.
- Established working group with County Soil & Water Conservation District to identify specific projects in the Oliver-Olin-Martin watershed to be submitted for consideration for funding by the Great Lakes Commission grant.

2017 PROJECTS

- Complete Phase 2 of sediment removal project in Dove Creek. 2017 Phase 2 cost \$38,450 (LARE grant \$30,760; OMLCIA cash match \$7,690).
- Applied for LARE grant for Aquatic Vegetation Management Plan project including spring invasive weeds survey, invasive weed treatment on Martin Lake only, post-treatment invasive weed survey and update AVMP. Total estimated cost \$12,700. (LARE \$10,160; OMLCIA \$2,540).
- S&WCD and OMLCIA working group to contact all property owners in the Dove Creek watershed to make them aware of the Great Lakes Commission grant and to identify potential projects to reduce sediment and nutrient runoff in the watershed.
- IN Dept of Natural Resources – Division of Nature Preserves to begin restoration of creek bank stabilization in Olin Preserve. Costs to be borne by IN DNR. Engineering work completed by OMLCIA and Davey Resource Group as part of 2014 Feasibility, Engineering & Design Study.
